Idea 1: Set targets

- Targets should be challenging and achievable.
- Targets should consider the process of teaching and learning.
- Ask your teachers to set SMART goals for **READING COMPREHENSION** (Specific ... Measurable ... Attainable ... Realistic ... Timed)
- For example: Two months after returning to school, learners will be able to answer grade appropriate multiple choice reading comprehension questions with at least 8 out of 10 correct.
