Segmenting and blending

Segmenting (separating sounds) and **blending** (combining sounds) are foundational skills that are necessary for learning to read. Children must be able to **hear** and **isolate** the sounds in words then **blend** the sounds they hear into a full word.

Method

- 1. Say the beginning sound of the word: /sh/
- 2. Say the middle sound of the word: /ar/
- 3. Say the end sound of the word: /k/
- 4. Say the word in full: **shark**
- 5. Repeat the method with your child using other words.
