## EFAL Foundation Phase: COVID-19 MESSAGING

Good day, School Principals, please provide parents with the following tips on how to support their children with reading at home:

## The focus this week is on Reading and making Connections.

When children read and make connections to the story/text, they compare this to their own lives, or to another story. Connecting to what he/she has read helps him/her develop an understanding about the feelings and experiences of other people.

## Choose a story your child can relate to in his/her life. For example, "A party for Sam"

- 1. How do you feel about this story?
- 2. What does this story remind you about?
- 3. How do you think the main character felt at the end of the story?
- 4. If you were the main character, what would you have done?
- 5. Did you like this story? Why? Why not?

Also find some tips on to how to share positive news & acts of kindness when needed:

- Make a get-well card for a sick friend or relative
- Check in on sick and elderly neighbours- offer to pick up and deliver shopping, or other things they might need, while taking precautions to keep yourself safe.
- Teach a skill to a group of friends or family singing, dancing, creative arts, how to play a game etc
- Share positive news and acts of kindness with your community- posting on social media or sharing with school friends and family
