Descriptive Adjectives

Descriptive adjectives are used to describe a person, a thing, an animal, or a place. They provide more detail, making it possible to create a picture of what the speaker or writer is talking about. Descriptive adjectives usually express things that are observable through the five senses (touch, taste, sight, smell, and sound). Some examples of descriptive adjectives are *soft*, *sweet*, *beautiful*, *fruity*, and *loud*.
