



Hello everyone. This week's message will focus on analysing comprehension questions with an emphasis on answering higher order questions. It's important for learners to:

- Read instructions carefully so that they understand what the examiner requires.
- Read questions carefully and answer questions according to the mark allocation.

Learners must know that they are various types of questions.

Types of questions:

1. **Contextual/ factual questions** *e.g who, what, where, when*
These questions require retrieval of facts from the text. Answers will always be in the text.
2. **Interpretative/inferential questions.**
These test understanding beyond the written word. Answers are derived from the text and own experience.
3. **Tone questions** *e.g How*
These questions address how the text conveys the writer's feeling, moods and attitudes.
4. **Questions to offer an opinion** are based on the assessment of information given in the text.
Learners must be able to substantiate their opinions.
