Idea 1: Motivating Mathematics teachers

- Always make them feel important and appreciated by acknowledging their achievements to build confidence
- Show your **trust** by demonstrating that you have faith in their abilities to get the job done
- Work on their **strengths** in order to correct their weak areas
- Encourage teamwork
- Communicate well and frequently to keep them in the loop on what is happening in the subject
- Positive communication is always key
- Be friendly ,empathetic, helpful and approachable(good working relationship)
- Where possible create support programmes for weak teachers(content or methodology workshops)

Idea 2: Working remotely with teachers

- **Share** professional ideas in the platform and solicit their opinion and use it as often as possible
- Encourage them to be resourceful and competent in their subject
- At times **motivate** individuals rather than teams
- Always remind them of the goal to be achieved in a friendly manner
- Set work expectations(plan)
- Provide on- going feedback
