In this section we review the steps followed when teaching a novel or drama.

Idea 2: Ideas on how to teach literature (Novel/Drama)

Pre Reading

- An activity is done to set the context, e.g. making predictions.
- Themes of the text are discussed in pairs/groups.

Reading

- A section of the novel/drama is read aloud, together with the class.
- The text is read and discussed using tables provided in the lesson plans.
- Discussion questions and possible answers are also included on the table at key points in the story.
- This is followed by a concluding discussion. Discussion questions are asked, and possible answers are provided.
- Journal questions are posed. Learners answer in their journals individually.

Post Reading

- Written and/or discussion activities are done to sum up the engagement with the novel/drama
