## LOOKING AT TARGETS TO ASSESS ACHIEVEMENT

Hello again, Maxwell here. Hope you are all keeping safe and healthy! Here is my next idea for you to help your teachers cover the curriculum.

<u>Idea 5:</u> Assessing achievement regarding curriculum coverage.

- Remind teachers of the real meaning of curriculum coverage, which include these three aspects:
  - -The prescribed curriculum: The guidelines, provisions and requirements of CAPS.
  - **-The implemented curriculum:** Plans & provisions made by teachers to ensure CAPS guidelines are honoured, and that the required topics are covered.
  - -The attained curriculum: The content covered is understood & assimilated by learners.
- We need to assess ourselves first as teachers before going to learner performance. How we
  collected evidence of learning, which would include: observations, performance tasks, projects,
  tests, written and oral language, visual communication. (Which were adequate / need to be
  reviewed / sustained?)
- How did learners demonstrate their learning? How do we know that learning took place? Did the set indicators and exemplars work appropriately?
- Did learners receive enough / sufficient ongoing feedback?
