Topic: Procedural text

Message Objective(s): To help learners:

- know the meaning of procedural text
- know the different kinds of procedural texts
- understand how procedural texts are written

Message: A procedural text is a text which gives instructions on how to make or do something. **Examples of procedural texts**

- Recipes
- Science experiments
- Instructions for playing games
- Manuals etc

Characteristics of a procedural text

- Uses action verbs e.g. Cut, Mix, Turn etc
- Uses simple present tense
- The information is presented in a step by step process.
- The goal is clearly stated.
- The materials or ingredients are listed.
- The steps are listed in order and are often numbered.
- Uses sequence words like first, then, next, finally are used.
