Consolidation work for week 1-2 term 2

As the social distancing is still being observed in schools and contact time is minimum, it is recommended that teachers prepare worksheets for learners to work on while they are at home. Inter-sen phase teachers should give learners work on the following concepts:

Grade 4 should work on multiples and factors of 1- digit numbers to at least 100.

Grade 5 practice work on multiplication to at least 3 digits by 2- digit numbers. They need to practice doubling and halving and view multiplication and division as inverses. Grade 6 should practice work on number sentences using the trial and improvement strategy.

Grade 7 and 8 worksheets focus on decimal fractions in terms of multiplication, division to at least 3 decimal places by wholes. While Grade 9 work on numeric and geometric patterns. They practice on representing patterns in diagrams and table form and identifying constant difference and ratio

Parents are encouraged to monitor and ensure that children complete the assigned work before they return to school.
