Towards the end of 2020, Honourable President Cyril Ramaphosa took time off his schedule to afford the National Reading Coalition (NRC) a sneak peek into his bedside table book collection. The top five books on his list are: *The lie of 1652 - A Decolonised History of Land* by Patric Tariq Mellet; *The Longest March* by Fred Khumalo; *Time is not the measure: A memoir* by Vusi Mavimbela; *Pan African Pantheon* edited by Adekeye Adebajo and *Blue Ocean Shift* by W Chan Kim and Renee Mauborgne.

An avid reader himself, President Ramaphosa took this opportunity to dedicate *The Longest March*, a novel by Fred Khumalo as the book of discussion for the second Virtual Reading Club session which was hosted by the National Reading Coalition on the 28 January 2021.

The third virtual reading club session will be conducted on the 24 February 2021 from 16h00 to 18h30. Football legend Simphiwe Tshabalala and radio personality Masechaba Ndlovu will be panellists for this session which will discuss *We need new names*, an unflinching and powerful story of a young girls' journey out of Zimbabwe to America by Noviolet Bulawayo.
