Comprehension Strategies

To help develop your children's comprehension skills at home, as you read stories to them, ask questions that will help them:

- 1. **Predict** what is going to happen in the story.
- 2. Remember the events and order of the story.
- 3. Remember details about the story.
- 4. Build his/her own opinion.
- 5. Make connections to the story.
- 6. Make judgements about the story.
- 7. Learn lessons from the story.
