TOPIC: Rebooting Education.

MESSAGE OBJECTIVE(S):

• Exploring lessons from the pandemic (LESSON 1) (assessment for learning)

MESSAGE: LESSON 1:

Without effective assessment for learning, it is impossible to meet the needs of individual learners.

• When planning for school reopening, it is important understanding where learners are in their learning as a precondition for catch-up.

Learning recovery will be most effectively supported if:

- I. teachers have information about the levels that learners are operating at; and
- II. they can monitor their progress over time and put additional support in place as needed.
- Before the onset of the pandemic most schools were preoccupied with 'summative
 assessment' at the end of a block of learning to measure whether learners have achieved
 the learning goals set out in the curriculum. Reopening of schools now provides an
 opportunity to increase focus on diagnostic and formative assessment.
 - ✓ **Diagnostic assessment** (as schools reopen), which helps teachers to ascertain the extent to which students' knowledge and skills are at the level expected by the curriculum.
 - ✓ **Formative assessment** (throughout the school year), which helps check students' understanding through classroom activities, quizzes, tests and homework.
