

YOUTH IN THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT

A programme of Sanitation Appropriate For Education (SAFE) – Department of Basic Education (DBE)

Available to unemployed Matriculants (18 to 35 years) and Built Environment Graduates (18 to 35 years) 25 January 2022

Invitation to Applicants

The National Education Collaboration Trust (NECT) in partnership with the DBE invites applications from young people (of between 18 and 35 years of age) to participate in the Youth in Built Environment Programme for a period of four (4) months. The successful participants will receive a stipend of R3800 per month.

The programme targets two groups:

- 1. **Unemployed graduates** with a Built Environment (Certificate or Diploma or Degree) Qualification recognised by relevant qualifications authorities.
- 2. **Unemployed matriculants** who would want to be trained as brick layers. The applicants should have a National Senior Certificate (NSC).

All applicants should be from the Eastern Cape Province and be willing to work in their respective Local/District to minimise logistical costs. The programme includes training covering the following aspects:

- 3. Classroom training for the bricklayer participants (4 Weeks)
 - a. Theoretical training (classroom training)
 - b. On the job training
- 4. Workplace experience (3 to 4 months)
 - a. Practical exposure to the world of work thereby becoming better job seekers and improved access to work opportunities when the programme comes to an end.
