ERRATUM NOTICE NO. 7

BID NUMBER: NECT/2026/05/007

TENDER DESCRIPTION: INVITATION FOR SERVICE PROVIDER TO PROVIDE FLEET MANAGEMENT SERVICES TO THE NECT FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS.

1. This notice serves to make revision on page 10 of the initial bid document which was advertised on the 8th of May 2026.
2. Bidders are requested to take note of the following amendment contained in this Erratum Notice No. 7:

2.1 Section 13: Mandatory compliance:

All tenderers are hereby informed that the following requirement contained in the tender document was inserted incorrectly and must therefore be deleted and disregarded:

“13(g) Failure of the service provider to indicate previous experience in software development/application customisation.”

The above requirement was included in error and must not be considered part of the mandatory requirements or evaluation criteria for this tender.

2.2 Insurance Requirements

Due to challenges experienced in obtaining the complete claims history, the insurance requirements contained or referenced in the following sections of the bid document will not be considered during the first stage of the evaluation process:

- Page 5: Insurance and Risk Management

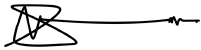
- Page 8: Section 8 - Eligibility and Minimum Requirements
- Page 8: Section 8 - Pricing and Cost Structure
- Page 12: Methodology and Technical Approach

Accordingly, bidders will not be penalised for not including insurance-related information at this stage and may disregard these requirements for purposes of the initial submission.

However, the insurance requirement will be reinstated for shortlisted bidders, who will subsequently be provided with all relevant information required to obtain and submit an insurance quotation.

3. All other information contained in the initial bid document, other than the amendment reflected above, remains unchanged.
4. Bid Closing Date: The original closing date remains unchanged as stipulated in the tender document, namely 29 May 2026 at 11:00 AM.
